What is Foursquare?

Community Foursquare Chapel is part of the family of churches officially known as the **International Church of the Foursquare Gospel**, a Protestant denomination founded by Aimee Semple McPherson in the 1920s. Foursquare derives its name from four key beliefs: Jesus is the Savior, Jesus is the Healer, Jesus is the Baptizer with the Holy Spirit, and Jesus is the Soon-Coming King.” These four distinctive are reflected in our logo above

Pentecostal Distinctive

We believe in the power and presence of God in the world today. Our keynote verse is Hebrews 13:8

Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.

Two Thousand years ago Jesus shared God’s love by saving, healing, and delivering people through the power of the Holy Spirit. He still does that today too.

What do We Believe?

The Bible is God’s Word to humanity, and it is good for every society and culture in the world in every age. The Bible does not need to be rewritten – it needs to be reread. The **Foursquare Gospel** is foundational to our doctrine.

Jesus is the **Savior** of the world. He is Emmanuel – God with us! As God’s own Son, He demonstrated God’s intent towards humanity by dying on a cross for the sins of the entire world. Jesus said, “No one comes to the Father but through me.”

The Baptism with the Holy Spirit.

God promised to pour out His Spirit on all flesh until the end of the age. It was called the “Promise of Father” and the “gift of God.” The Baptism with the Holy Spirit is still available today for the power to serve God.

Power to Heal and Deliver. We are told Jesus came to destroy the works of the wicked one. Jesus healed and delivered people through the power of the Holy Spirit and told His followers to do the same.

Jesus: The soon-coming King: The Bible is clear that Jesus will return to earth, defeat Satan, and take His place as King over the earth. We live and serve with this hope for a better future.

What to Expect?

We are glad that you have joined us today – or are considering it. Churches are different in their styles of worship and ministry. What should you expect when attending **Community Foursquare Chapel**?

Vibrant Worship: Worship should be joyful and authentic. We sing a mix of traditional hymns, choruses, and contemporary worship music. We encourage you to worship in any way that feels natural to you.

Spiritual Gifts: As a Pentecostal Church we are open to the Gifts of the Holy Spirit (1 Corinthians 12). During the service you may see someone stand to share a short “word” with the rest of the congregation. This is proper according to 1 Corinthians 14. We do not believe ministry is limited to a few professionals, but God wants to use everyone on occasion.

Ministry of the Word: We are a Bible-believing and teaching church. Expect solid Biblical teachings that are instructive, encouraging, and relevant to your life and society today.

Personal Ministry: We always offer a time of personal ministry for those who want prayer for healing or any other reason. We will pray for and with you.
